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**ORDER RE STATE BAR COURT BUSINESS  
RELATED TO STATE BAR FACILITIES CLOSURE**

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Beginning March 17, 2020, the State Bar closed its offices in San Francisco and Los Angeles to the public. The State Bar has taken this measure out of an abundance of caution and in an effort to protect staff and the community due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Consequently, the State Bar Court filing window and the courtrooms are closed to the public, effective March 17, 2020 through Monday, April 6, 2020.

On a case-by-case basis, the State Bar Court will continue to conduct what it deems to be essential business in order to fulfill the primary purposes of discipline, which includes protection of the public, the courts, and the legal profession; maintenance of the highest professional standards; and preservation of public confidence in the legal profession.
