
DISQUALIFICATION OF STATE BAR COURT JUDGES  
PURSUANT TO RULE 230 OF THE TRANSITIONAL RULES  
OF PROCEDURE

---

As used in rule 230 of the Transitional Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California, the term "supervising referee" shall refer to the Supervising Judge in the venue in which a matter is pending and the term "presiding referee" shall refer to the Presiding Judge of the State Bar Court.

Where the motion for disqualification pursuant to rule 230 is directed against the Supervising Judge, the motion shall be presented directly to the Presiding Judge.

The motion for disqualification shall be made promptly after the assignment of the judge is first known to the party making the motion or to the party's counsel, and in any event before the introduction of evidence at trial, or the commencement of any review conducted by the Review Department, as the case may be.
