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**ORDER RE USE OF REPROVAL STIPULATION FORMS**

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Except as provided herein, any Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition to a reproval (Reproval Stipulation(s)) that is submitted to the State Bar Court for approval after May 26, 2022, must use the stipulation forms available on the State Bar Court website at <http://www.statebarcourt.ca.gov/FORMS> on May 19, 2022. These forms were revised to reflect amendments to rule 5.127(A) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar, effective May 19, 2022.

The court will accept fully executed Reproval Stipulations using the prior version of the form, effective January 1, 2021, until September 2, 2022, without further order of the court for cases in which a party has prepared and submitted to the opposing party a proposed Reproval Stipulation prior to May 26, 2021.

Any party seeking to submit a Reproval Stipulation that does not comply with this order, must file a motion in advance that is supported by a stipulation signed by all parties and shows good cause why the May 19, 2022 form was not utilized.

With respect to Reproval Stipulations, this Hearing Department General Order supersedes Hearing Department General Order 21-08.
