IN THE HEARING DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE BAR COURT

ORDER RE USE OF STIPULATION FORMS

Except as provided herein, any Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Disposition or Alternative Discipline Program (ADP) Stipulation Re Facts and Conclusions of Law submitted to the State Bar Court for approval after January 12, 2026, must use the stipulation forms, available on the State Bar Court website at <http://www.statebarcourt.ca.gov/Forms>, on January 1, 2026. These forms were revised to reflect, among other things, recent modifications to Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California, rules 5.137 and 5.380 et seq.

The Court will accept fully executed stipulations using the most recent prior versions of the forms until March 1, 2026, without further order of the Court for cases in which a party has prepared and submitted to the opposing party a proposed Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Disposition or proposed ADP Stipulation Re Facts and Conclusions of Law on or before January 12, 2026.

Any party seeking to submit a stipulation that does not comply with this order, must file a motion in advance that is supported by a stipulation signed by all parties and shows good cause why the January 1, 2026 forms were not utilized.

This Hearing Department General Order supersedes Hearing Department General Order 24-19.
